



Rules Governing Use of the Sports Hall:

All users **must** have a booking to use the Sports Hall. No unauthorised access. Please check-in at the sports reception prior to booking commencement.

Strictly **No** football boots, high heels, or black sole shoes to be worn in the Sports Hall. Therefore, non-marking athletic footwear **should** be worn in the Sports Hall **at all times**.

No food or drink allowed in the Sports Hall. Exceptions for water/sports drinks in an appropriate resealable plastic bottle/container are permitted. Strictly **no** glass bottles. Any spillages must be reported immediately to a member of staff.

Chewing gum is **prohibited**.

No bags allowed in the Sports Hall. It is compulsory that all personal belongings **must** be stored in the lockers provided. Lockers will be emptied at closing time; they are **not** for overnight use.

There shall be **No** changing in any place other than the designated changing rooms provided.

Users should ensure that no matter what game/sport or event, safety guidelines are followed.

Any incidents/accidents should be reported immediately to a member of sports staff.

Antisocial activity of any kind is **prohibited**. Any incident should be reported to a member of staff.

Users will not intentionally provoke an opponent or teammate, whether verbally or physically.

TU Dublin Sport will **not** accept responsibility for any private property that may be damaged, lost or stolen on the premises. Lost property will be held for a maximum of 14 days.

This use of recording devices is **prohibited** in the entire building, unless prior approval has been granted by management.

All equipment is to be moved by TU Dublin sports staff only i.e. Futsal Goals. Users will use the sports equipment for its intended purpose only. Any defects in equipment should be reported immediately to a member of sports staff or via email (sportfacilities@tudublin.ie).

Users are **not** permitted to access the storerooms. These areas are for sports staff only. Prior permission must be obtained from the Sport Facility Management team to store any equipment in any of the storage areas.

Users are **not** permitted to operate the basketball nets controls. Please contact the reception.

Sticky or masking tape of any kind is **prohibited** on the Sports Hall floor without prior approval from the sports management team.

Users should respect the time of the next booking and be out of the hall at the end of the allocated timeslot.

No smoking or vaping in the sports building or entrance to the building. Please use the designated campus smoking zones.

If a shower is required, it must be taken 15-minutes prior to the building closing (i.e. 9.45pm weekdays & 4.45pm weekends) and the premises vacated by 10pm or 5pm respectively.

Users acknowledge that the rules of the hall must be upheld at all times.

Any individual or group in breach of these rules will have their booking suspended until further notice or in certain cases cancelled.

The management of TU Dublin Sport Facilities reserves the right to amend and add to these conditions of membership and rules as it sees fit. All users shall observe any amended or additional conditions or rules so made. Any changes to these conditions will always be displayed on our website or complex reception.
